




Summit: 10,000 feet

2100: Only snow at upper 25% of mountain

2075: No snow at base elevation of 6,890 feet

 - **>**1,137 lost jobs




- >2050

 - ➤ 1,520 to 3,717 lost jobs






Municipal Carbon Inventory


Top 8 Departments: Represent 90% of total


Municipal CO₂ Emissions - Park City










Idling: The Ultimate "Oil Spill"









Solar Feasibility Study Conclusions

- **≥**34 Total Sites Evaluated
- >=> 13 Suitable Sites for Solar PV Panels
- >=> 184 kilowatt (kW) total rooftop capacity
- >> 294,000 kWh annual generation capacity
 - 3.3% of total annual municipal consumption (Buildings + Water Operations)
