

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
Source of Information

Individual Market Area Factor Range for Insurers by Region, 2017




All areas factors are calculated in relation to the Denver factor. The Denver factor is therefore set at 1.00.

Two carriers have a 61.5% differential between their highest and lowest area factors.


For example, one carrier has 0.852 factor in Colorado Springs and 1.376 in the West.

Total Cost of Care (Annual), 2014-15




2014 claims cost ranges from \$4,073 to \$5,532, a difference of 36%.

Total cost is per capita

Example

- 20 people are insured for a full year
- Only 1 of these 20 people has an inpatient stay, costing \$30,000
- Cost per Unit = \$30,000
- Total Cost = $$1,500 ($30,000 \div 20 \text{ people})$

Total Cost = Number of Units (Utilization) * Cost per Unit


Notes on More Detailed Analysis

- Yellow highlighting are categories where Region 9 Total Cost per Member per Year is more than 1.5x the All Regions Total Cost per Member per Year.
- Reminder that this analysis is based on where the person lives, not where the service is provided.


Common Cost Patterns by Region

- Significant difference in all measurements (ranges from 20% to 50%+ differentials)
- Substantial differences in cost per service for inpatient, outpatient and professional
- Denver and Boulder lower cost in most segments
- In a one region scenario, in general, the East and West Premiums would be lowered and Denver, Boulder and Colorado Springs would cover the most of the needed revenue increase
