TOWN	NOTES
<b>Silverton</b>	
Mountain Village	"During an active snowstorm the vehicle will be towed immediately and may be ticketed"
Aspen	
Minturn	"Limited tow option due to limited resources"
Crested Butte	"Alternate parking in residential areas from north to south and east to west sides of the street."
Park City	
Jackson	"Any vehicles parked in violation of the snow tow ordinance are ticketed by the police and subject to being towed. Towing of vehicles usually only happens for street maintenance (i.e. snow removal). If no street maintenance is taking place, then vehicles are only ticketed."
Winter Park	
Fraser	
Telluride	"Tow at the direction of Public Works when they determine the need to clear the street. In the middle of winter, we tow between five and thirty vehicles per week from the Town Streets. "
Vail	
Steamboat Springs	"Warning to vehicles or a ticket if they have received a previous warning. We very seldom tow vehicles because of the bad PR associated with a Ski Resort area
Breckenridge	"If a PW plow operator calls and reports a parked vehicle obstructing snow removal, the vehicle is ticketed and towed. Tickets in these cases are municipal code tickets with a penalty assessment."
