## Where We've Been...




- Transit was operated seasonally as a private system by Winter Park Resort – approximately \$1.2M annual cost
- Town of Winter Park contributed \$400,000 annually
- Town of Fraser contributed \$60,000 annually
- Additional contributions from HOAs and charter services
- Resort threatened to cut service in 2010 to area of unincorporated
  Grand County adjacent to Fraser created significant public discussion on the need for service to be public...


- Engagement with Winter Park Resort (August 2014)
- Result Development of Memorandum of Understanding to transition service from private to public
- MOU approved in May of 2015
- MOU required:
  - Transfer of existing service contract from the Resort to the Town
  - Town would consider placing a ballot measure in front of voters for sustainable revenue stream
  - Resort would contribute \$300,000 annually for 10 years for capital

- Engagement with Town of Fraser (March 2015)
- Result Development of an Economic Development Strategic Plan
  - Early identification of improving transit as top priority
- Towns engaged transit and financial consultants to evaluate budgets as well as potential ballot measures
- Towns agreed to measures requesting sales tax increases for transit and trails
  - Winter Park 2%
  - Fraser 1%

Thinking about various methods of financing community initiatives, would you support an additional sales tax of up to 2% to fund transit, trails and capital improvements?

Election Results are in! November 3, 2015:

• Fraser Measure 2A: 207 – 98 (67.8% approval)

Winter Park Measure 2C: 187 – 132 (58.6% approval)

Public transit operations commenced on November 11, 2015

• Total contract cost: \$1,748,018.43


• Cost per rider: \$3.59

• Summer ridership: 20,337


• Total summer cost: \$143,984.55

## Where We Are Going...

- Bus Procurement
  - Acquired 15 transit-style busses from RTD and Steamboat Springs
  - Awarded grants for 3 new busses (2 transit, 1 cutaway) in 2016
- Grant Awards
  - \$1M in operating/capital for 2016, \$150,000 in operating for 2017
- RideHop smartphone app
  - Late September deployment
- Marketing and branding of transit system
  - Kickoff in August, new logo/color scheme/maps to be implemented prior to ski season
- Facilities Master Plan
