- Pedestrian friendly













Location

 Biggestage groups are ages 30-39, followed by ages 0-9 and ages 20-29


Population by Employment Status:




Ute Indian Tribes




- Early pioneers

Waste Reduction

2018 Bag Ban: Ban on disposable plastic bags provided by retailers to customers at the point of sale. 10 cent fee on paper bags.

2020 EPS Ban: Ban on use of expanded polystyrene take out food containers.



Tobacco & Cigarette Tax

- 2018- Avon raised minimum age to purchase tobacco products from 18 to 21.
- Voters approved a 40% sales tax on tobacco products (excluding cigarettes) and a \$3/pack excise tax on cigarettes
- Tax generated over \$350k in 2019
- Projected to generate over \$450k in 2020
- Eagle County approved a \$4/pack cigarette tax in 2019
