


U.S. Real GDP

U.S. Nonfarm Employment


U.S. Nonfarm Employment, Monthly, Millions of Jobs

Months to Recovery from Recessions


U.S. Nonfarm Employment, Number of Months Since Recession Peak


U.S. Unemployment Rate, Monthly






National Personal Income










Colorado Goods Exports by Country 2021













Colorado Employment Forecast








Colorado 2022 Employment Change










Unemployment Rate by County, December 2021












Colorado Ski Counties Covered Wages












State Net Taxable Sales by County

November 2021 YTD Compared to November 2019 YTD







FHFA Home Price Index by State


1-Year Home Price Change, Q4 2021

Permits, 1997-2022






