The Mountain Towns 2030 Solutions Project (MTSP) is a cohort-based program that provides targeted leadership training and real-world expertise to equip every participant with an impactful pathway to carbon neutrality.



MTSP Is Designed To:



- Demonstrate how carbon is at the heart of many of the issues we face
- Take the discussion from the intangible to meaningful impact and benefits
- Build capacity in communities that need resources to execute their climate action planning
- Quickly build confidence and knowledge in impactful climate actions
- Create a toolbox of peer actions, projects, and progress that will make an immediate impact
- Facilitate continued collaboration & networking outside of the cohorts via an online collaboration platform, accessible by every participant

The MT2030 Solutions Project



- Six month climate action planning program, managed my MT2030, focused on driving change
- Monthly virtual convenings each month diving into one solution per month
- Each convening will feature a topical expert, a community example, and a group collaboration/discussion
- The conversation will be continued online on a community platform enabling participants to continually connect with colleagues
- You will work with peers and experts to create an actionable plan that illuminates a pathway for climate action

Six Topical Modules:



- Week 1: Making the case
- Week 2: Efficiency, Renewable energy, and buildings
- Week 3: Transportation
- Week 4: Zero waste
- Week 5: Innovation (example: Nature-based solutions)
- Week 6: Wrap/Next Steps

Participant Expectations:



- Actively participate in the modules
- Work with peers
- Contribute content, best practices and track progress
- Help develop their plan and implementation strategy

MT2030 Will:



- Provide facilitation and structured information for each module
- Create an impactful plan for each participating organization
- Curate an online forum to continually share ideas and best practices
- Support participants in their climate journey. Example: giving a local presentation, helping in collecting and editing strategy, and connecting with peers that have similar areas of focus

- \$2,500 per community
- Timing: January June 2023
