


U.S. Quarterly GDP, \$ Trillions

U.S. Nonfarm Employment







U.S. Nonfarm Employment, Number of Months Since Recession Peak







National Industry Employment Recovery




Monthly Recovery Rates from Jan. 2020 – Dec. 2023, All Office Building Types









Personal Income and Savings


Trillions, Seasonally Adjusted Annual Rate



Percent of Disposable Income



Percent of Disposable Income



Consumer Price Index, Percent Change Year-Over-Year








Colorado Change in Population








Colorado Labor Force and Job Openings








Year-over-Year Percent Change, December 2023




Colorado 2024 Estimated Employment Change


Average Weekly Wage Growth





Resident Labor Force Growth



Resident Employment Change




Resident Unemployment Rate

December 2023





Colorado Ski Counties Covered Employment





Colorado Ski Counties Total Covered Wages





Colorado Ski Counties Average Covered Wages



Indexed Employment






Tourism Covered Employment

DIA Monthly Passenger Traffic, Thousands, 2000-2023





National Retail Sales vs. Colorado Taxable Sales





Taxable Sales 4-Year Change


2023 YTD Compared to 2019 YTD December
